Mary Kay Super Bowl Squares Instructions

How It Works

- Put names of each Customer that purchases minimum \$ 10 in a square (ie: she purchases \$ 26—her name goes in 2 squares. \$ 102. her name goes in 10 squares). It is recommended that you place them randomly on the grid.
- At the beginning of the game, when you cut-off all orders, you will put numbers-1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 0 in a bowl—draw one out and write the number in the 1st blank space at the top going across. Then draw again and put in second square going across until all 10 squares have a number in it. (you can use a deck of cars. 1-10, where 10 = 0). Do not add the numbers, before your order cut off. People will want to choose their spot then, and try to pick the "Good" numbers. This will cause you more work, and perhaps some drama. Add the numbers after your cut-off, right before the game begins.
- That the numbers back in the bowl and draw again to fill the squares on the left going down.
- Write the name of the Home Team across the top, and the Visitor's Team along the left side.
- Whatever the score is at the end of the quarter or 1/2, you will take the last number of the score and follow down and across until the numbers meet.
- For example, if the Home Team is winning at the end of the first quarter and the score is 14 to 7, then the person whose name is in the square where the 4 at the top (home team) and the 7 going down (visitor's) meet will be the winner of the free product. (Go down from 4 and across from 7)
- If there is a name in that square, then that person wins the free product for that quarter of the game.
- You can call your winning customer right after the quarter. She will be excited!
